Rules for validating the year

2 requirements

- Average grade each semester: ≥ 10
- Average grade in each course: ≥ 7

Additional constraints

- Grade for the internship: ≥ 10

How to verify that you validated a semester

Your transcript should ends with a keyword such as **Admitted** or **Admis(e)**

- Might not appear for now if you are registered at Ensimag
- In case of doubt, contact Elise Ros

If not, you should attend 2nd session exams

2nd session exams

Exams that you have to attend

- Exam for any course with an average grade below 7

Exams that you may attend

- Exam for any course with an average grade below 10 (but above 7)
- This rule is true only if you did not validate the semester

Other comments

- Any course with an average grade above 10 is permanently validated

2nd session exams

How it works

- The 2nd session grade replaces the grade of the 1st session exam
 - But the continuous assessments grades remain

Special case of the max rule

- The max rule: Only your exam grade is kept if it is higher than your average grade for a course
- Courses that apply this rule:
 - Programming language and compiler design (1st and 2nd session)
 - Software engineering (2nd session)
 - Introduction to cryptology (2nd session)
 - Fundamental Computer Science (2nd session)

Special cases

Waiving the compensation between courses to retake some exams

- You have validated the semester with a grade for some courses below 10
- You can decide to waive the compensation rule to take the second session exam for some of these course
 - **In this case, you lose the 1st session grade**
 - Risk of failing the semester if your grade in second session is lower than the one in first session

Semester validated despite failing to meet one criteria

- The jury may have decided to validate your semester even if you were not meeting one criteria
 - In this case, you do not have to attend 2nd session exams
 - This only happens in very specific cases

Important dates

2nd session exams

- 1st semester: June 23 -- June 27
- 2nd semester: July 1 -- July 7

Defining the list of exams you will retake

- **End of February:** Deadline for defining the list of (optional) exams you decide to retake
 - Send an email with your list to the administrative supervisors and the heads of the master

Waiving the compensation between courses

- **February 10, 1pm:** Deadline for waiving the compensation for the first semester
 - This request must be sent by email to the administrative supervisors
